

YOUR HELP IS NEEDED TO PRESERVE  
68 ACRES OF SANIBEL LAND



The "Ding" Darling Wildlife Society has been working behind the scenes to find ways to acquire 68 acres along Wulfert Road and San-Cap Road, which have been approved for development by the City of Sanibel. The Society currently has an option to purchase this land to delay the development, but time is of the essence. If this acquisition can work, it will ultimately be a partnership with the Society, Lee County and the Refuge.

The proposed acquisition recently passed the Conservation Land Acquisition & Stewardship Advisory Committee. This is the step necessary to move the property forward for consideration by the Lee County Commissioners for acquisition using Lee County 20/20 funds. We anticipate this is going in front of the commissioners for a vote in November.

You can help in these efforts by contacting the Lee County Commissioners and sharing with them how important protecting these 68 acres are to you and to the island community for conservation and water quality.
