Earlier this year, Sanibel's City Council authorized a study to recommend changes to make our Shared Use Paths safer. And now City Council needs your help to evaluate those recommendations.



City of Sanibel hosts open house for input on Shared Use Path Study

There were nineteen recommendations in the study's report, including....

- A new crosswalk by the CVS Pharmacy driveway
- Adding vertical stop signs on the paths at certain major intersections

- Removing pavement stop markings at other intersections
- Reconfiguring the vehicle entrance to Ding Darling
- Adding additional warnings on roadways before crosswalks
